GCSE Results 2016

There are now four "headline" measures for schools. One of them, "Progress 8", can only be calculated once all other schools' results are known. Saint Aidan's 2015 Progress 8 figure was +0.16 (well above national average).

Percentage of students gaining English Baccalaureate ^a	32%

^aThe English Baccalaureate figure is the percentage of students who have taken and obtained at least a Grade C in English, Maths, at least 2 sciences, a humanities subject and a modern language.

^bThe Attainment 8 figure is worked out by combining scores in Maths, English and a number of other GCSE subjects.

Results for each GCSE subject are below. The proportions of each grade can sometimes vary from subject to subject because of the different groups of students sitting each subject.
